Toast to Good Neighbor medical clinic

Over 100 people turned out on Wednesday evening at Blue Spoon Café in Prairie du Sac to enjoy an Alfresco Wine Tasting to benefit the Good Neighbor Medical Clinic. Attendees paid \$35 to sample wines from around the world and enjoy hors d'oeuvres in support of the free clinic. The Good Neighbor Medical Clinic has served the Sauk Prairie area since 1998. Its doctors, dentists and nurse provide free medical service to those without insurance. About \$1 million of free healthcare services has been provided to the community since its conception. Along with the wine tasting a silent auction was held. Items in the auction were donated by vendors of Blue Spoon Café and Culver's Restaurants.
